TREE DEDICATION PROGRAM

The Parks Maintenance & Operations Department is pleased to be able to offer a **Commemorative Tree Planting Program.** This program may be used as a form of remembrance of a loved one, celebration of a birth, honoring a retiree, or any other event, which you feel, should be commemorated by a living tribute. Trees will be planted in approved areas within City parks.

CONDITIONS:

- 1. Parks Operations reserves the right to:
- a) Approve the preferred species of the tree.
- b) Approve the site for planting and suggest alternative sites. (No Longer Planting in Chingucacousy Park, Gage Park, Charles F Watson Park, Professors Lake, Eldorado Park, Norton Place Park, or City of Brampton Golf Course)
- c) Purchase the tree and deem the tree healthy upon its arrival.
- 2. Tree planting will be conducted twice yearly.

ORDER FORM (For Parklands - Tree and Plaque)

- a) Approximately May 15 June 15 with orders received no later than March 15th.
- b) Approximately Sept. 15th November 1 with orders received no later than July 15th. Due to timelines for the production of the bronze plaques the program closes July 15th each year.
- 3. Once planted, the tree becomes the sole responsibility of the Parks Department, who will endeavor to keep the tree properly maintained.
- 4. Total costs are payable to the City of Brampton in care of the Community Services Department. **Payment must accompany application.** All costs may be subject to change without notice.
